How many articles do I need to propose ? What is the frequency ?

You may propose as many articles as you want and when you want. There is no minimum number. You are able to stop when you want.

Do I need to pay for publishing an article ?

As soon as your article is written in a journalist style and is not an advertisement, the publication (when accepted by our journalist) is free.

You want to propose a Press Release ?

You don't need to be a reporter to propose press releases related to the « Aging ». Just send them at : info@agetimeseurope.com

How can I propose my article ?

Just send your article (photos...) directly in Word format with :

- a maximum 8 word long title
- one line of introduction
- your article in a journalist style
- photos
- at the end, you may add your description (bio, services, products...). This part and **only this part** may be an advertisement.

Whose copyright ?

As long as the article is written by you, the copyright is yours. You are responsible for the contents and you are able to request to AgetimesEurope.com to remove your article at any time.
